SO, HOW DO YOU GET HERE?

Hearst, Ontario is located in the center of Northern Ontario

From Thunder Bay: Take the Trans Canada HWY 11 East. The approximate travel time is 5.5 hours.

From Sudbury: Take the HWY 144 North to HWY 655 North. This leads to the Trans Canada HWY 11 West. The approximate travel time is 6.5 hours.

From Northwestern Quebec: Take the Trans Canada HWY 117 up until the Quebec border. Subsequently, the route becomes 6 West. Continue to follow this road to HWY 11 North. The approximate travel time from Rouyn-Noranda is 5 hours.

From Sault Ste-Marie: Take the Trans Canada HWY 17 North to White River where you take HWY 631 North towards Hornepayne up to the Trans Canada HWY 11 East of Hearst. The approximate travel time is 6 hours.

From Toronto: Take HWY 400 up until the Trans Canada HWY 11 North. The approximate travel time is 10 hours.
